

# Story of “Self” and Three Questions

Divide your bargaining unit, include fee payers and non-members, into manageable groups of 3-5 or 5-10.

Find enough member volunteers who are out-going and congenial and assign each a group.

Volunteers will strike up a conversation beginning with their story of “self” with each of their designated bargaining unit members, face-to-face, one-on-one to find and record the answers to the following important questions...

Executive Committee and/or Membership Committee members follow-up with non-members to discuss their answers and potentially joining the Association.

Volunteers report their findings to the Executive Committee who decides potential course of action.

1. What excites you most about your profession?
2. What bothers you or takes the joy out of your profession?
3. What is the solution?  
Or, how can we work together to find a solution?
